### CALL FOR PAPERS No. 03/2024 - PRODER/UFCA

The Federal University of Cariri – UFCA, through the Graduate Program in Sustainable Regional Development (PRODER), announces and invites the academic community to participate and submit scientific works under the conditions outlined in this call for papers, for the VIII Scientific Journey of PRODER and the I International Conference on Health and Sustainable Development of UFCA, to be held from December 2 to 4, 2024.

### **INTRODUCTION**

From December 2 to 4, 2024, the VIII Scientific Journey of PRODER and the I International Conference on Health and Sustainable Development of UFCA will take place, promoted by the faculty and students of the Academic Master's Program in Sustainable Regional Development (PRODER/UFCA), in partnership with the Master's programs in Family Health (PROFSAÚDE), Health Sciences, and Administration (UFCA).

The theme of the event is: **City and Society: Exploring the Intersection of Environment, Health, and Territory**. This initiative seeks to foster interaction between the university and the community, promoting the dissemination of scientific work, awareness of projects carried out by the academic community, learning opportunities, knowledge exchange, lectures, workshops, short courses, and technical visits.

### I LOCATION

1.1 The event will be conducted in a hybrid format (in-person and online) across UFCA campuses and virtually via Google Meet and YouTube. ## II REGISTRATION

2.1 Registration will be completed via an online form, available at: [https://forms.ufca.edu.br/](https://forms.ufca.edu.br/), starting on October 6, 2024, and closing at 11:59 PM on December 2, 2024.

2.2 Event registration is contingent upon the completion of the required form. Participants are kindly requested to donate 1 kg of non-perishable food, which can be delivered at the registration desk located at the entrance of the Beata Maria de Araújo Auditorium, Block H, ground floor, on the Juazeiro do Norte Campus of the Federal University of Cariri (UFCA), at Avenida Tenente Raimundo Rocha, No. 1639, Cidade Universitária district, Juazeiro do Norte, Ceará State.

2.3 The registration of at least one (1) author is mandatory for the presentation of the submitted work.

2.4 Registration grants participants access to all lectures and one (1) short course.

## III ATTENDANCE

3.1 At the beginning of each activity, a link or physical document will be made available for participants to record their attendance.

## IV DA SUBMISSÃO DE RESUMOS

4.1 Abstracts must be submitted through the link: <u>https://forms.ufca.edu.br/logout.do</u>, by 11:59 PM on November 6, 2024.

4.2 When submitting the paper, the level of the course (Undergraduate or Graduate) must be indicated).

4.3 If the author wishes to present the paper, the responsible author must be registered for the event.

4.4 At the time of submission, the presentation format (poster or oral) must be



specified. All oral presentations will be conducted remotely.

4.5 Each abstract may have a maximum of three (3) authors, including the main author, co-author, and advisor. Each participant may submit up to three (3) abstracts as the main author, with no limits on co-authorship in other submissions.

4.6 Submissions may be made in the form of simple abstracts.

4.7 The works must address one of the following thematic areas:

- ENVIRONMENT
- HEALTH, STATE, AND SOCIETY
- TECHNOLOGY AND MODELING
- HEALTH SCIENCES
- ADMINISTRATION

4.8 At the time of submission, the thematic area indicated in this call for papers must be specified.

4.9 Only one format of scientific work will be accepted: a simple, unstructured abstract containing information related to the introduction, objectives, methodology or methodological procedures, results, and conclusions.

4.10 The abstracts must not contain direct citations, footnotes, or bibliographic references.

4.11 Acknowledgments are mandatory for scholarship recipients and funded projects.

4.12 The abstract must strictly follow the template provided on the website: <u>http://proder.ufca.edu.br/</u>

4.13 The abstract must not disclose the identity of the author(s); identification will be managed through the electronic submission form.



4.14 Once the work has been submitted, modifications to the uploaded file will not be allowed.

4.15 The work must be submitted in either DOC or DOCX format.

# V – EVALUATION OF ABSTRACTS

5.1 The works will be evaluated through a peer-review process, which will result in one of the following decisions: approved, approved with revisions, or rejected.

## VI - APPROVED WORKS

6.1 The results of the submitted works will be announced by November 25, 2024, on the official pages of the participating courses, in the virtual dissemination platform of the VIII Scientific Journey of PRODER, via the website: <u>http://proder.ufca.edu.br/</u>, and on the event's Instagram page.

## VII PRESENTATION OF WORKS

7.1 The presentation of works (poster and oral) will take place on December 3, 2024, from 2:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. The oral presentations will be conducted in a virtual environment via the Google Meet platform on the same date and time. The presentation link and schedule will be announced in advance (at least 24 hours before the scheduled time). Time changes between participants will not be allowed.

7.2 The evaluation of the work will consider the following aspects::

7.2.1 Structure (Introduction, objectives, methodology or methodological procedures, results, conclusions, and the relevance of the topic to the selected line of research).

7.2.2 Creativity in the presentation/design of the poster and oral presentation.

7.2.3 Mastery of the topic addressed.

7.2.4 Adherence to the allocated presentation time. Coherence between the oral



presentation and the submitted abstract.

- 7.3 Each presentation will be allocated 10 minutes for the exposition and 5 minutes for comments and feedback from the evaluation panel.
- 7.4 Approved works will be certified and published in the proceedings of the VIII Scientific Journey of PRODER and the I International Conference on Health and Sustainable Development of UFCA.
- 7.5 A presentation certificate will only be issued for approved works that are effectively presented..

### VIII ON AWARDS

The top three works from each category (Undergraduate, Master's in Family Health, Health Sciences, Administration, and Proder, with the latter awarding by research line: Health, State, and Society; Technology and Modeling; and Environment) will receive certificates of honorable mention.

### IX GUIDELINES FOR THE WORKS

- 9.1 Abstracts must be written strictly following the template available through the link on the PRODER webpage: https://proder.ufca.edu.br/ and submitted in Word format for evaluation.
- 9.2 Abstracts must be justified, in Portuguese/English, using Times New Roman font, size 12, with single line spacing, and contain between 200 and 250 words. They should provide a brief report of the research/experience, presenting in the third-person singular the introduction, objectives, methodology or methodological procedures, results, and conclusions.
- 9.3 Posters must be produced in strict accordance with the guidelines provided in the poster template available through the link on the PRODER webpage:



https://proder.ufca.edu.br/.

- 9.4 Abstracts must be justified, in Portuguese/English, using Times New Roman font, size 12, with single line spacing, and contain between 200 and 250 words. They should provide a brief report of the research/experience, presented in the third-person singular, including the introduction, objectives, methodology or methodological procedures, results, and conclusions.
- 9.5 Posters must be produced strictly following the guidelines outlined in the poster template, available through the link on the PRODER webpage: <a href="https://proder.ufca.edu.br/">https://proder.ufca.edu.br/</a>


